

New Zealand CHECKLIST – DOGS

Export date

EHC Proposed Signing Date (within 2 days of export)

Microchip number:

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED BEFORE APPOINTMENT:

- Rabies vacc card (including batch no., microchip no. and implant/scan date) – If primary vacc, given between 6-12 months before export date. If booster vacc, given within 12 months of export date.
- Rabies blood test (between 3-24 months of export date).
- Rabies blood test validation.
- OVD.
- Permit – breed on the permit needs to match EHC.
- Owner/Exporter declaration.
- If older than 6 months, Heartworm Ag ELISA test within 30 days of export.
- Leptospirosis blood test (MAT) within 30 days of export.
- DOGS that have been to AFRICA – Imidocard dipropionate OR Babesia canis bloods.
- External parasite treatments X2 within 30 days of export date, at least 14 days apart, 2nd one within 2 days of export date.

- Internal parasite treatments X2 within 30 days of export date, at least 14 days apart, 2nd one within 4 days of export date (must cover Heartworm).

- Brucella canis SAT within 16 days of export date.
- Babesia gibsoni PCR tests x2 on samples collected 30-37 days apart, and the 2nd sample within 16 days of export.
1st sample..... 2nd sample.....
- EHC on DEFRA PORTAL.
- EHC pre-filled and saved in TRAVEL VET shared folder.

TO PRINT FOR SIGNING APPOINTMENT:

- Rabies Blood Test Report.
- Blood test results for Heartworm, Leptospirosis, Brucella canis and Babesia gibsoni.

AFTER APPOINTMENT:

- EHC certified and copy emailed to AGENT
- EHC closed on DEFRA PORTAL
- EHC uploaded to EZYVET and INVOICED
